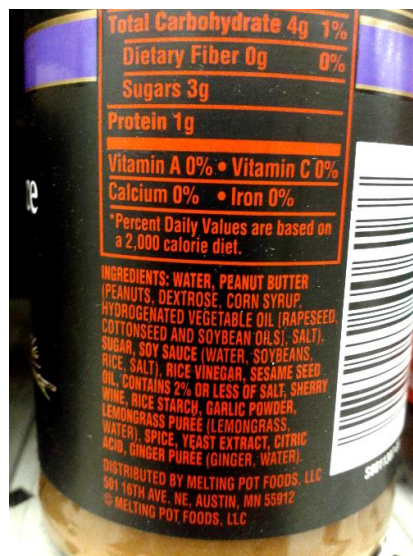

## Parking Lot Reminders

It can get very conjested at drop off and pickup so...



- please go slowly, and be mindful of others when parking and exiting your vehicle.
- make use of all lots (upper, lower and back parking lots) to avoid crowding.
- when entering, follow the traffic pattern around the lower parking lot and stop at the stop sign before proceeding up the ramp.
- when volunteering please park in the spaces closest to the school building.

This is so we can let our families know that these sicknesses are going around. Your child's name is never mentioned when sharing this information.



It's very important to keep a close eye on your children and their siblings at all times. For their safety, hold hands in parking lots, reminders to walk in hallways and don't allow them to sit or climb on cubbies.
